### Course details

Students who are interested in **caring professions, social work, teaching, psychology, child care, nursing including midwifery, sociology, elderly care or mental health care.**

Work can be independent and involves research skills. Discussion plays a vital role in the delivery of the course.

Students who are capable of giving opinions and interpreting factual material will do well.

Students that have taken the subject at GCSE/Level 2 must have grade C/PASS or above in Health and Social Care and grade C/5 in English Language and Science.

Is the subject open to students that have not taken HSC at GCSE? - **Yes**

Students that are new to the subject must have grade C/5 in English Language, Science and Maths.

There will be two more internally assessed units which have yet to be chosen. Those under consideration are:

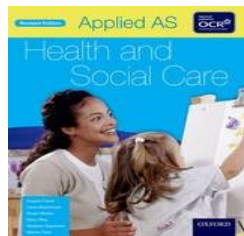
Nutrition for health, Psychology for HSC, Infection control and supporting people with learning difficulties

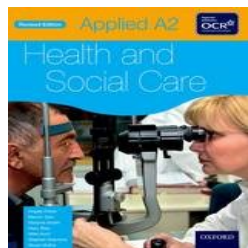

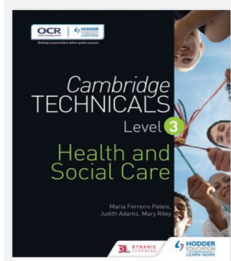
