- During the Induction you will have a personalised timetable to follow introductory lessons in the subjects chosen on your application form and at interview.
- Please bring a pen and some A4 file paper/notepad – you'll need to write some things down!
- Food and drink will be available on-site during break and/or lunchtime cash or card is accepted.
- It is your responsibility to ensure you bring any medication that you may require during the day.

The Year 12 Induction provides you with an excellent opportunity to get a feel for Sixth Form life; meet your staff and fellow students and gain an insight into your level 3 courses. Some transition work will be issued during lessons for completion over the summer break. This will support your start to courses in the Autumn Term.

## Wigston College Dress Code

To reflect a modern working environment there is a dress code for all students. We believe that high standards of personal appearance equate to high standards in all other matters.

### Students should not wear:

- Ripped jeans
- Sports or beach wear (i.e. no jogging bottoms or gym shorts)
- Clothing with offensive slogans
- Crop tops
- Inappropriate footwear such as flip-flops and sliders



This list is not exhaustive and individual judgements may be made by the Sixth Form team. **Inappropriately dressed students may be sent home to change.**

Students are allowed to wear shorts during warm weather periods. Shorts must be tailored shorts and not sports shorts or hot pants.

### PE Dress Code

Students who have a practical PE lesson during the day are welcome to come to College in **PE kit** and are welcome to change at any point afterwards into normal College clothes.

The key to our dress code is that you should wear smart attire in-keeping with a professional place of work and study.
